

This set of Anti-Prom Paper Dolls is a supplement to *Kindling: Activities to Spark Joy and Belonging Gathered from Around the World,* by Christine Wong Yap, artist-in-residence at large in *Mindscapes* (the Wellcome Trust's cultural initiative exploring mental health) and nearly 100 contributors. The four-zine set features 85 step-bystep instructions generated and handdrawn by nearly 100 everyday people in 11 community-based workshops held in four cities in a yearlong project. - A photocopier OR printer and computer or mobile device with access to the Internet
- Markers, colored pencils, or crayons
- Scissors
- Glue or tape (optional)


## INSTRUCTIONS


- Print the following pages. (This PDF is downloadable from ChristineWongYap.com/ AntiPromPaperDolls or scan the QR code).
- 2. **Color** the dolls and garments. Be creative and mixand-match outfits to express your unique style!
  - Optional: Create your own garments on blank paper.
  - Optional: Color hair or accessories.
- 3. **Cut out** the dolls and garments. If you have glue or tape and just want to style the garments once, ignore the tabs sticking out from the garments. If you don't have glue or tape, or if you'd prefer to style and re-style the garments, be sure to include the tabs. Repeat with the hair and accessories if used.
- 4. **Dress** the dolls by using glue or tape to adhere the garments to the dolls, or folding the paper tabs over the dolls. ■






























































